FALL 2017 SPECIAL YARD WASTE COLLECTIONS SCHEDULE

These collections are for occupied residential properties only.

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS – What you need to know.

Regular household garbage is not part of these collections. Collection is for <u>occupied</u>, <u>residential properties</u> only; vacant lots, commercial, and industrial properties are not included. Items must be at the curb by 6:00 AM; materials placed for pickup at any other time may not be collected.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

<u>DO:</u> Place leaves, grass clippings, pine needles and cones, and garden waste in a paper or plastic bag, or (maximum) 30 gallon container.

Cut brush into 4 ft. lengths and bundles no larger than 18 inches in diameter.

DON'T: Mix in stones, rocks, metal, other inorganic matter, dirt, sod or other materials.

Town Holidays and Refuse Collection Schedule

<u>Thursday & Friday, November 23 & 24-Thanksgiving.</u> Trash will be collected on Wednesday, Nov. 22. No recycling collection for Friday.

Friday, December 22 (offices close at noon) & Monday, December 25-Christmas AND Friday, December 29 (offices close at noon) & Monday, January 1-New Year. No change to Friday, December 22 and 29. Recycling for Monday, December 25 & January 1 on Tuesday December 26 and January 2 along with regular Tuesday trash collection.

<u>Live-cut Christmas tree collection. Wednesday January 3 & 10.</u> Must be free of all decoration and at the curb by 7 AM.

Monday, January 15-Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day and Monday, February 19-Presidents Day. Recycling collection normally scheduled for Monday will be collected on Tuesday along with regular Tuesday trash collection.
