#### c. Regular Session of 08.22.22:

Councilmember Orris stated that on page five Ms. Hedlesky was referring specifically to speeding on West Street and not Town-wide, he wanted to see the corrections made in that statement. - 2. Presentation Worcester County Arts Council Executive Director Anna Mullis, Board President Dr. Donna Main, and Board Member Jim Meckley presented updates to the Mayor and Council about events held this year and the upcoming Paint Worcester County event. They said the opening reception for the event will be held at the Worcester County Library in Berlin Friday, September 23, 2022, from 1:30 pm until 5:00 pm and that painting would be available for purchase. The Mayor and Council thanked them for their work in the community.
- 3. Public Hearing: Ordinance 2022-06 Amending Chapter 8, Article II, Section 8-30 Short-Term Rentals (STR)

Planning Director Dave Engelhart presented the changes to the STR ordinance. Mayor Zack Tyndall opened the Public Hearing at 7:26 pm.

Resident Todd Martinek asked for clarity on primary residence; Mr. Engelhart said it would require someone to live at the property for 180 days or more annually. Mr. Martinek then asked how many applications had been received thus far; Mr. Engelhart said 13. Mr. Martinek then suggested the Town place a cap on the number of STR allowed in Town limits. Town Attorney David Gaskill said they are not allowed to place caps if they are in an eligible zone.

Resident Woody Bunting asked for clarity on if "owner occupied" was included in the original language; Mr. Engelhart said it was not, but that it was discussed as an alternative to the primary residence option; He further added that no one is required to be on the property at the time of the rental with the current language in the ordinance.

Resident James Walsh asked why it took six months for the language to be clarified; Mayor Tyndall explained that there is a process for any changes to the Town's ordinances.

Devin and Kristin Potler read a letter from Ms. Potler's mother, an STR owner explaining that they feel unwelcome and that they had planned to use their STR as a retirement property, but feel the recent changes will not allow them to continue operating their STR. Councilmember Orris asked what zone the Potler's property was in; Mr. Engelhart said they are in the R2 district.

Resident Marie Velong stated that because STRs are a controversial topic, perhaps they should form a separate committee or have each case reviewed by the Board of Appeals. She also asked if there will be an annual review process to determine if the property is still a primary residence; Mr. Engelhart said it would be reviewed annually. Ms. Velong then asked if this would impact accessory dwelling units; Mr. Engelhart said it would, but that is a much broader topic that will not be discussed this evening.

Resident Kim Holloway questioned when the 28-day room tax would apply to an STR; Mr. Engelhart said that is managed by the County but would be required after continuous stays of 28 days or more.

Resident Anne Pollack expressed concerns about having transient rental properties in her neighborhood and noted that there are several families in the community looking for long-term rentals.

Councilmember Knerr asked if it is true that if a property is an LLC it cannot be declared as a primary residence; Mr. Gaskill said he would think that is correct but would need to clarify. Mr. Potler stated their property is under an LLC; Councilmember Nichols stated that an LLC could also operate as a long-term rental option.

Resident Cam Bunting said when she sells homes, she often tells buyers to be aware of the STR regulations if that is their intent when buying.

Resident Ryan Nellans said with his current zoning he can rent his property as an STR but asked for clarity on the process of zoning changes; Mr. Engelhart said a zoning district can change and explained the process if that were to occur.

With no further questions or comments from the public, the Public Hearing closed at 8:03 pm. On the motion of Vice-President Burrell, second by Councilmember Nichols, the Short-Term Rental Ordinance amendments, were approved by the following vote:

#### 4. Motions for Approval:

a. 2022-09: Award of Contract for Henry Park Basketball Court Lighting

Town Administrator Mary Bohlen and Electric Utility Director Tim Lawrence recommended Musco Sports Lighting to complete the lighting at the Henry Park Basketball Courts, noting that they are the same company that did the Tennis Court lighting project, which the Town was satisfied with. Councilmember Orris asked why this did not go out to bid; Mr. Lawrence stated that they are a member of Sourcewell which is a bidding service and of which the Town is a member, eliminating the need for the Town to undergo the bidding process.

Mayor Tyndall added that the Town's obligation on the overall project is \$10,000 and the remaining funds are from the grant with DNR.

## b. 2022-10: Award of Contract for RFP 2023-01 Storm Drain Replacement Project Water Resources Director Jamey Latchum

Mr. Latchum reminded the Mayor and Council that the storm drainpipe at 105 Washington Street has failed and that EA Engineering designed the replacement project, and the project has gone out for bid; He stated four bids were received. EA has recommended Goody Hill and asked they be awarded the project for the bid amount of \$124,443.

Mayor Tyndall asked Mr. Latchum for confirmation to confirm that the Town allocated \$110,000 for the project from ARPA, a difference of approximately \$15,000. Mayor Tyndall asked if the remaining balance needed for the project would come out of the remaining stormwater funds. Mr. Latchum said the overall project cost was estimated at \$124,000 but emphasized that if some of the proposed alternatives could be done ahead of time, it could knock off roughly \$7,000 from the overall projected cost.

Mayor Tyndall asked if the \$15,000 would impact the other R2 grant applications the department is trying to pursue. Mr. Daryl Kolar said this would not apply to other grant applications. Mr. Kolar added that the most recent grant application submitted has allowed them to team with Maryland Coastal Bays, and they offered a leverage amount and letter of commitment for \$10,000.

Councilmember Knerr asked Mr. Latchum to confirm that the drain line being discussed runs from Washington Street along the property line at 105 to the end of the ditch. Mr. Latchum confirmed, stating the plan is to collapse the terracotta pipe in place and put the new pipe five feet off the property line and that the Town has been granted the appropriate easement. Councilmember Knerr asked if the easement was not there before; Mr. Latchum said it dated back to 1878.

Councilmember Orris further reviewed the ARPA spending plan, stating that the \$14,000 overage will not have an effect.

Councilmember Orris asked for clarity on how these are submitted. Ms. Jensen said they are left with Customer Service, and they give the request to the Mayor. Mayor Tyndall added that if time allows, he adds it to the Council's Agenda for approval.

6. Approval of We Heart Berlin's request to hold Love Day at Henry Park on September 25<sup>th</sup> Adrian Bowen and Mary Hedlesky were present on behalf of We Heart Berlin and explained their request. Mayor Tyndall stated that the Park's Commission had a favorable recommendation for the event but stated that it would place a burden on staff resources. Ms. Hedlesky said they will only need police services for traffic control; Mr. Bowen added that at past events they clean up after themselves and do not typically require additional services from the Town. Ms. Bohlen said that the Public Works Department would need to provide additional trash cans, clean up the park, and clean the bathrooms and that both the Police Department and Public Works will be providing services Downtown for the Fiddler's Convention that weekend, putting a strain on available resources; She also added that it is a requirement to give a 60-day notice to the Town when requesting use of the parks and Town services. There was a discussion over holding the event later and Mayor Tyndall added that if We Heart Berlin would like the event to take place annually, they should make the Town aware as soon as possible.

#### 7. Termination of a Lease

Town Attorney David Gaskill explained that the Town had a lease with a private party to use a portion of the old processing plant and parking lot but has been awarded a demolition grant for \$500,000 for the property. Before proceeding with the demolition project, the lease needed to be terminated to give the tenant sufficient time to vacate the building.

#### 8. Town Administrator's Report – Mary Bohlen

Ms. Bohlen reviewed details of the Town Power Outage, confirming that it will begin Saturday morning September 17, 2022, from 12:01 AM through 6:00 AM. She noted the Board of Elections met Wednesday, September 7, 2022, and will meet again on Tuesday, September 27, 2022, for election training. Ms. Bohlen added that September 27, 2022, serves as the deadline for any write-in candidates, and any write-in candidates will be certified at the meeting on September 27, 2022.

#### 9. Departmental Reports:

a. Economic and Community Development Director – Ivy Wells

Ms. Wells returned to Councilmember Orris's question regarding the current wording included in the event application. She stated that per the event application insert, all events must be submitted between July 1 and September 1 to present events for approval. Ms. Bohlen clarified that the 60-day filing is noted in the Parks Code for Special Events. Ms. Wells said the Small Town Throwdown was sponsored by the Atlantic Hotel on Saturday, September 10, 2022. The stage used at the event was larger than anticipated, which affected the time of the planned road closures for the event. Ms. Wells said she, Administrative Assistant Allison Early, Alan Parkinson, and Councilmember Orris represented Berlin at the newly renovated Homes at Berlin during their community fair. She thanked Councilmember Orris for speaking at the event. Ms. Wells has been reviewing security cameras and Modular Vehicle Barrier Requests for Proposals (RFPs); she has been continuing with meetings and demos. She will also be speaking at the Shore Leadership session on September 21, 2022, at the Berlin Library. Ms. Wells is working on the Maryland State Arts Council Annual Report for the A & E District, adding that it is a very lengthy report and takes several weeks to compile. She also added that she is working on the quarterly department grant report for the Community Legacy, Main Street Improvement, and Strategic Demolition Grants. She said that an Advisory Board meeting for the A and E District was held, and within the next several months, A & E Chairman, Sonny, will be presenting an overview of the future goals of the district. Ms. Wells noted that the Mandala Pies ribbon cutting will be held Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 PM, and Berlin's new restaurant, 410 Social, has also officially opened. She added that the Berlin Community Yard Sale will be Saturday, October 22, 2022; D3 has created a sign-up form for participation and will put the form on the Town website once it is finalized. She will release the names and addresses of participants one week before the date of the yard sale. The Town Bulk pick-up is one week after the yard sale, which will allow residents to get rid of their items. Ms. Wells has also created all the graphics for the yard sale, power outage, social media, and other upcoming events. She stated that she will be on vacation out of the country from September 23, 2022, through October 2, 2022, and will not be accessible during this time.

b. Planning and Zoning Director – David Engelhart Mr. Engelhart had no further updates.

#### c. Electric Utility Director - Tim Lawrence

Mr. Lawrence reviewed the Demands, Meter, and Net Meter Readings (Re-readings) throughout the town. He said this is the time of year to install and remove several banners and event panels, which occurs almost every week. He added the "big event" occurred on Flower Street, in which a utility pole was hit by a car on September 7, 2022, at 2:48 AM and knocked out Circuit 230. Most of the power was restored within an hour, with all power being restored by 12:30 PM. He added that the department has replaced a faulty transformer at the Decatur Street Extension and has continued with tree trimming and additional pole top maintenance. Mr. Lawrence said that workers have continued preparation at the Savage Substation for the planned power outage on September 17, 2022. He said that he hand-delivered a letter to all homes across the street from the site to make them aware of the work, that light towers will be installed on the premises, and it may be noisier than normal during the time of the planned work. Mr. Lawrence closed his report by mentioning that the power plant peak shaving occurred Monday, August 28, 2022, from 2:30 PM to 5:20 PM and again on Tuesday, August 30, 2022, from 2:30 PM to 4:40 PM.

#### d. Police Chief - Arnold Downing

Chief Downing was not present at the meeting to provide a report.

#### e. Finance Director - Natalie Saleh

Ms. Saleh noted that Monday, September 12, 2022, was the first day of the PKS audit, which will continue through the rest of the week. She said the department is printing and mailing bills on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, but is hoping that more people will continue to sign up for E-Billing. Mayor Tyndall asked Ms. Saleh if the Town can send the power outage notices to the E-Billing customers. Ms. Bohlen answered saying Billing Supervisor Melissa Coffey is looking into that.

#### f. Water Resources Director – Jamey Latchum

Mr. Latchum said the department had to pull an effluent pump from the treatment plant to send out for emergency repairs. He said they are working on the drying bed fans, which are currently not running. Mr. Latchum added that two of his employees have tested to receive their MDE certifications. He noted that the recent power outage affected their lift stations; his workers had to come in to ensure they had power. His department has completed meter readings and re-reads. Mr. Latchum attended a stormwater meeting with EA. He closed his report by stating the contractor finished painting the Franklin Avenue water tower which will be back online for water storage by Friday, September 16, 2022.

#### g. Public Works Director – Jimmy Charles

Mr. Charles said that with school going back in session, he has been receiving a lot of calls from the Transportation Department concerning low limbs hitting busses; they had been out the past two weeks to improve this. Public works prepared for the Small Town Throwdown event held Saturday, September 10, 2022, by closing streets and cleaning up after the weekend. He added that Public Works team members helped with traffic control while electric was being restored as a result of the Power outage following damage to the utility pole on Flower Street. Mr. Charles said Public Works Building Maintenance Division has been painting around the town building, painting offices, and hallways. He also said that the department was able to purchase ten new metal barricades, which will be used at Town events. This purchase will be covered by the downtown grant. Mr. Charles also said that a new race car was installed at the playground in Decatur Park. Mayor Tyndall thanked Mr. Charles and his crew for the work they did after the Small Town Throw Down event. Vice-President Burrell also thanked Mr. Charles, stating he was impressed by how clean the area was after driving through Town the next morning. Vice-President Burrell asked Mr. Charles if there was a schedule for street sweeping; Mr. Charles

answered that he tries to work with the trash route, but it should be occurring every week on every street.

#### h. Human Resources Director – Kelsey Jensen

Ms. Jensen said that she has been working with the new Administrative Assistant, Kate Daub, on training. She added that there are a few new positions that have been posted with the Town, specifically the Mayor's Assistant/Public Information Officer and a Part-Time Seasonal Public Works Employee. Councilmember Orris asked Ms. Jensen to clarify the role of the Part-Time Seasonal employee and asked for clarification to confirm that funding for this position was still in the Public Works budget. Ms. Jensen provided confirmation. She added that she will soon be posting for a Plant Operator Trainee and still has openings for a First Class Lineman, Police Officers, and Police Communication Officers. She also compiled information for the PKS audit and is still working on the Workers Comp audit. She added that a Flu Clinic has been scheduled for September 21, 2022, from 11 AM to 12 PM, which is open to all employees and their families. She has scheduled training sessions with LGIT, specifically mandatory Harassment training, and Civility in the Workplace, a new training offered. Ms. Jensen said she is working with state retirement to try and get the LEOPS process started. She also said that she did put out the RFP for the salary survey and the step and grade system, noting that bids are due back by October 7, 2022, and will continue working through some things before that process starts. Vice-President Burrell asked Ms. Jensen to clarify the training portion for the Plant Operator Trainee position. Ms. Jensen stated she and Mr. Latchum were thinking of dropping the "trainee" portion and implementing more hands-on training at the workplace. Mr. Latchum added multiple classes are offered and said he would ask the trainee to sign up for them which would be supported by the Town. Vice-President Burrell asked if there was anything in place that would then bind the individual to the Town following completion of the classes; Ms. Jensen said at this time, there is nothing in the current handbook that states this, however, it is something being worked on and will be discussed at a future Mayor and Council meeting.

#### 10. Comments from the Council:

Councilmember Nichols complimented Mr. Lawrence and Mr. Charles on their response following the electrical outage as a result of the down utility pole accident.

#### 11. Comments from the Mayor:

Mayor Tyndall provided a reminder for Walk Maryland Day to be held on October 5, 2022, at 4:30 PM. He said the plan is to have a walk at Stephen Decatur Park and a ribbon cutting to celebrate the new pathway.

#### 12. Comments from the Public

Resident Marie Velong asked if there are plans for Ethics Training for the Ethics Committee. Mayor Tyndall acknowledged it is overdue and there are plans to coordinate training. Ms. Velong also asked if the audio-visual equipment is on the budget for this year. Mayor Tyndall said that it is being funded through ARPA and is an approved expenditure, but because of the number of RFP's it has been delayed. Ms. Velong asked if any council members have walked the pathway to realize that it does not need paving all over, adding that paving may not be necessary. Mayor Tyndall confirmed that the pathway will receive new asphalt. Ms. Bohlen stated what is there now is intended to be a sub-surface. Ms. Velong also shared her concerns about the branches blocking the stop sign on Washington Street, as well as other signs throughout the Town, and asked that this be addressed.

Resident Mary Hedleskey asked if the council had a chance to review the information for West Street. Mayor Tyndall said the information has been sent to the contractual grant writer to review

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whether the Town may be eligible. Ms. Hedleskey asked if anything temporary can be done in the meantime to help with speeding, and Mayor Tyndall said that is also something being addressed by the grant writer to discuss options. She also asked for an update about the property on Main Street. Mr. Engelhart responded saying he talked to the owner/representative and there is a meeting scheduled for Friday, September 16, 2022, with architects and engineers to come up with a final plan.

Vice-President Burrell asked if the Town or State has any authority to go on private property to eliminate things that obstruct signs on the highway, specifically stop signs. Mr. Engelhart said that the property owner is responsible for ensuring there is no obstruction. Mr. Engelhart said if the owner does not comply, the owner would be held in violation.

#### 13. Comments from the Press – none.

#### 14. Adjournment:

On the motion of Vice-President Burrell, second by Councilmember Purnell, the Mayor and Council meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:14 PM.

**SUBJECT:** Berlin Police Department Recruitment and Retention

#### **SUMMARY**

The Chief of Police, Town Administrator, Human Resources Director, and Mayor began meeting regularly on June 29, 2022, to discuss the recruitment and retention issues facing the Town of Berlin Police Department. Following our meeting on June 29, 2022, an executive session was scheduled with the Mayor and Council for July 11, 2022, to brief the entire group on the public safety challenges that existed within the Town of Berlin.

Regular meetings continued between the Chief of Police, Lt. Fisher, Town Administrator, Human Resources Director, and the Mayor. During the meetings, the following items were discussed:

- Creating a Field Training Officer (FTO) shift differential of \$1.75 per hour while a Berlin Police Officer is training a new Berlin Police Officer
- Increasing the Town of Berlin's evening shift differential (after 2:00 PM) to \$0.65 per hour and the midnight shift differential (10:00 PM) to \$0.80 per hour so the department is competitive with other law enforcement agencies
- Bringing the Police Department inclement weather policy in line with what is currently
  offered to other Town Staff when they are called into work during times of inclement
  weather (2.5x normal rate when the Mayor and Town Administrator authorize the
  closure of Town Hall)
- Making the holiday compensation rate competitive with other law enforcement agencies by paying (1.5x normal rate for all holidays with the exception of Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day when officers would receive 2x their normal rate of pay)
- Additional payments for law enforcement officers working in specialty areas:
- The Chief of Police and Human Resources Director are working to gather all the information needed to begin the LEOPS study. Submission to the State of Maryland will occur in September/October of 2022 and the Town should have the findings available for the FY24 budgeting process (January/February 2023).

- Piloting a 1099 employee to assist with fingerprinting services and other duties
  determined by the Chief of Police for a period of 6-months. The salary of this position is
  expected to be fully covered by fingerprinting fees. If the position requires the use of
  salary dollars not generated by fingerprinting fees during the 6-month pilot period, the
  position will not be renewed.
- The Chief of Police, Lt. Fisher, and the Human Resources Director, have determined salary adjustments that need to be made across the entire department to equitably compensate officers based on experience and years of service within the department. These adjustments should account for the changes that have been made in the base rate of pay during the FY23 budgeting process to make our department competitive from a recruitment perspective.

Additionally, at the time of this memo the department has nine officers working, two officers out on medical leave, three true vacancies, but hiring for four, and has received a total of five applications. We are currently recruiting for four officers to help account for the vacancies and attrition.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

The financial projections associated with Option 1, Option 2, and Option 3 have been compiled using figures provided by the Police Department, Human Resources, the Finance Department and the LEOPS study completed in February of 2019. Each option contains the immediate budgetary impact as well as a projected future budgetary impact for each fiscal year moving forward once adopted.

Option 1 produces a \$75,000 increase in FY 23 and potentially a \$315,000 impact in FY24. The total cost in FY24 would be carried forward to all future fiscal years.

#### **OPTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION**

Currently, there are three options available for consideration. The options have been created using information discussed during several meetings proceeding June 29, 2022, with the goal of addressing the recruitment and retention of law enforcement officers for the Town of Berlin.

#### RECOMMENDATION

After much discussion, the recommendation is to pursue Option 1 which includes salary adjustments for law enforcement officers, increases to shift differential pay for officers working evening and mid-night shifts, additional pay for officers training new recruits, specialty unit pay and additional compensation for K9 officers, inclement weather pay, holiday pay, and the increases to FICA and the MSRS. The anticipated change to the FY23 budget would be an increase of \$75,000. These costs would carry forward to future fiscal year budgets.

The pursuit of Option 1 will be funded in FY23 using residual salary dollars from police department vacancies and reimbursements from workers compensation. The Town of Berlin is also pursuing \$35,000 in grant funding to offset overtime expenditures in FY23.

The major difference between Option 1 and Option 2 are the adjustments to salaries which will cost approximately \$40,000. Prior to making the recommendation to pursue Option 1, the Finance Department conducted an analysis of budgeted vs. actual overtime expenditures for the

Police Department in FY22 and FY23. In FY22 the Town of Berlin budgeted \$70,000 in overtime for the Police Department and expensed \$132,000. In FY23 the Town of Berlin budgeted \$80,000 in overtime for the Police Department and without adjusting our operations or funding we are on course to expend \$136,000 in overtime this fiscal year (i.e., \$56,000 over budget). Therefore, we believe that there is potential to mitigate FY23 overtime costs for the Police Department by making the salary adjustments outlined in Option 1.

This recommendation is not made lightly, since it will represent an additional \$75,000 in salary expenses each fiscal year which may impact the Town of Berlin's ability to direct those cash flows in other directions.

Option 1 also includes information about the potential cost of entering into LEOPS in FY24. These costs have been extracted from the LEOPS study that was conducted in February 2019 and contain a projected net/adjusted cost of \$240,000 per fiscal year. The cost of LEOPS would carry forward to future fiscal year budgets.
