This meeting was also broadcast live via Facebook. Following a moment of silence and the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor Tyndall called the meeting to order at approximately 7:20 PM.

2. Annual Parks Development Plan

Acting Town Administrator Mary Bohlen presented the Annual Parks Development Plan and stated that this item was tabled from last meeting to give the Council a chance to discuss the plan and priorities with the Parks Commission and We Heart Berlin representatives. Parks Commission representatives Mike Wiley, Sarah Hooper, Laura Stern, Patricia Dufendach, and Bruce Hyder were all present and available for any questions about the plan. Mayor Tyndall said this plan was developed after a park inspection where the Town was made aware of safety concerns with aging infrastructure. The Council asked the Parks Commission to explain some factors that lead them to determine inclusive playground equipment at Stephen Decatur Park (SDP) to be the top priority. The Parks Commission started by saying they are not against a skatepark, but they do not have enough information about it to make it a top priority, the biggest thing being a location. They then discussed several factors they took into consideration when making the inclusive playground equipment their top priority including inclusivity, likelihood of grant approval and attainability, location, plan, assisting with flooding concerns, safety, and modernization. The Parks Commission then said a few other things that are desired but not a top priority are tot lot, bathrooms at SDP, and a skatepark. Councilmember Orris asked them to give their top location options for a skatepark; the Parks Commission said without having community or professional input they would say maybe Heron Park or Worcester County's property, which may not be an option. Mayor Tyndall with input from the Council suggested that the Parks Commission try to make it to each park and determine what if anything could be improved at each property to come up with a list of options for future consideration and to see if they think a skatepark would be possible in each area. Councilmember Knerr then asked the Parks Commission if they have had an opportunity to review the Beacon Study for the skateparks; they said individually they reviewed it, but it was eye opening with pricing, seemed incomplete, and seemed to be geared towards Henry Park. The Parks Commission also stated a few concerns they had with pricing past install, maintenance, and that they are only citizens and not professionals, so they feel choosing a location on their own could be challenging. Councilmember Knerr asked why the Town would apply for grant funding for a study instead of the actual skatepark; Ms. Bohlen said because they would need pricing and a plan in place and that is not feasible with their filing deadline. Vice-President Burrell asked the Parks Commission to work on an action plan for getting a skatepark in motion; they said they are happy to work on that but may require some professional input on some items. The Parks Commission also wondered if it was possible to even consider Heron Park as an option if they Town is looking to sell it; Mayor Tyndall said they are still in the early stages of discussing the future of the park. Ms. Bohlen then stated that the deadline for the grant submission is August 24th so she will need some direction soon.

Town Residents then discussed their opinions on a skatepark in Town.

Resident Mary Hedleskey said a plan needed to be in place for moving forward and stated that the Town's actions and what they are saying do not align; she said the contradicting comments are frustrating as a resident and she wants to see teens have a safe space to go.

Resident and President of We Heart Berlin Tony Weeg, stated that there is not going to be too much management needed for Town employees, most skaters take the time to clean the parks, most of their funding is on a deadline too, he said he had until June 1, 2023, on some of the funds they have received. He said skateparks are inclusive, many people in wheelchairs and people of all ages, genders, and races can all get together. He also stated that he disagreed with the comments about the study seeming to be incomplete. He said skateparks are typically done in phases (\$250,000 per phase) and run approximately \$750,000 total. He then stated that if the Town wanted the skatepark to be a priority they would have already made it one and been working through details.

Resident Gina Velong discussed an option of breaking it up to include it in SDP instead of Henry Park, especially if the Town is considering new playground equipment and things can be moved around. She said a visual would be helpful for residents to know what it may look like, especially because Mr. Weeg has expressed interest in a pump park. Mr. Weeg said he did not feel SDP would be a good location for it and said he sees SDP as the kid's park, Heron Park as the serene nature park, and Henry Park as the basketball and teen park. Vice-President Burrell expressed concerns with stormwater, flooding, and noise at Henry Park and asked if that is why they want it there because it's loud; Mr. Weeg said no, he loves Henry Park, but with 113 running alongside it is already a very loud space.

Resident Mary Fury said she is fully supportive of a park and said when they moved here her son wrote the Mayor a letter asking for a skatepark. She stated that kids get in trouble for skating in town and it is not fair when they have nowhere to go, especially because it could keep them out of trouble. Mayor Tyndall said they do see a path forward and will be trying to make it a reality.

Ms. Bohlen said the skatepark and We Heart Berlin will be topics on the Parks Commissions September 6th agenda, but she does need to know if she should proceed with the application for the inclusive playground for presentation to the Mayor and Council on August 22, 2022. Consensus was to proceed. Councilmember Orris asked when they can expect to hear back about the grant; Ms. Bohlen said usually late summer or early fall the following year, so 2023.

3. Fourth Quarter Financial Updates

Finance Director Natalie Saleh presented the fourth quarter financial updates and said these figures are still very much preliminary figures. The Council thanked her for putting the presentation together and following a consistent format, so it is easy to follow each quarter.

4. Acting Town Administrator's Report – Mary Bohlen

Ms. Bohlen reported that they received notification that the milling and paving of Graham Ave., Stevenson Ln., Decatur St., and Stephen Decatur Park's walking path is scheduled to begin the week of August 16th to be completed by August 31st. The Parks Commission was at National Night Out on Tuesday, August 2nd with a free kid's craft. She is working with Ivy Wells on Request for Proposals (RFP) for downtown security cameras and vehicle barricades for events. She is working with Tim Lawrence on the RFP for the basketball lighting. And lastly, she and Kelsey Jensen have begun the interview process for the Administrative Assistant position in Administration. Councilmember Nichols said she was excited to see the milling begin before school starts.

5. Departmental Reports:

a. Planning and Zoning Director – David Engelhart

Mr. Engelhart reported that the Planning Commission will meet on Wednesday, August 10th at 5:30 PM to review a Text Amendment to the Short-Term Rental Ordinance for a recommendation

to the Mayor and Council which clarifies the requirement for properties in the R-1 and R-2 single family residence districts to be the owner's principal residence. The first reading of this will take place at the Mayor and Council Meeting on August 22nd and the Public Hearing will take place on September 12th. Councilmember Knerr asked if there have been any enforcement issues so far; he replied no but said they have not issued any licenses because they wanted to get the amendment taken care of first.

b. Electric Utility Director - Tim Lawrence

Mr. Lawrence reported that they have a scheduled outage for upgrades at Rite Aid. They replaced faulty transformers at Mallard Ridge and on Bay Street. They installed panels at Henry Park for the National Night Out Event. They completed meter and demand reads. They also generated at the power plant on July 24th, 28th, and August 3rd, 4th, 5th, 8th, 9th, and 10th the heat is taking its toll on the Town's equipment.

c. Police Chief – Arnold Downing

Chief Downing reported that The Berlin Police Department sponsored the annual National Night Out coordinated by Retired Senior Officer C. Holland on August 2nd. On August 4th Chief Downing, Retired S.O. C. Holland, PCO L. Purnell, and Records Clerk B. Downing chaperoned the Berlin Youth Club on a trip to the Altitude Trampoline Park and Delmar Pizza in Delmar, DE which was sponsored by the Berlin Police Department Crime Prevention Fund.

d. Finance Director – Natalie Saleh

Ms. Saleh reported that the billing and customer service departments have been working on the new rates for capital service fees and are holding progress meetings for smart meters. They are doing audit prep work, they have had several more e-billing sign ups, and are looking into allowing customers to pay over the phone through a third-party software Tyler offers. Lastly, she addressed the total costs related to the Town Officials attending the LESMA dinner which was hosted by the Town. Councilmember Orris asked if it is standard for the hosting Town to pay for the guest speakers; Mayor Tyndall said it is, they did not expect to have three, but it worked out that way. Councilmember Knerr asked what fund and account that was charged to; Ms. Saleh said Elected Officials Travel. Mayor Tyndall added that he wants Ms. Saleh to explore credit card fees being assessed to individuals paying by card.

e. Public Works Director – Jimmy Charles

Mr. Charles reported that they prepared Henry Park for the National Night Out by cutting grass, trimming weeds, mulching, and power washing the pavilion. They also helped the Berlin Police department with setting up barricades and cleaning up at the end of the event. He also reported that with the help of a local vendor, they have installed new locks in the downtown restrooms which unlock at 6 AM and lock at 9 PM. The Henry Park restroom locks were repaired and unlock at 7 AM and lock at 8 PM. In the 2023 Budget he indicated that they have \$20,000 in reserves to extend the sidewalks along Tripoli Street down to the Stephen Decatur Park parking lot; he and Mary Bohlen had a conversation with Darl Kolar from EA to discuss rain runoff and to if a site plan was already created, then they will be able to work on getting bids. He and Tim Lawrence discussed the Commerce Street parking lot project and removing the three remaining trees, getting prices on light poles, undergrounding the electric, and the electric charging stations placement. Councilmember Nichols asked if he had taken the American Flags on the fence down at Henry Park; he said he did, they are not great quality flags, so he only planned to put them up for events or holidays.

f. Human Resources Director - Kelsey Jensen

Ms. Jensen said she and Mary Bohlen reviewed applications for the Administrative Assistant position and established interview questions and scheduled four interviews for this week. She and Jamey Latchum reviewed applications for the three water openings, they scheduled an interview for the Stormwater Laborer position, are bringing back a past employee for the Spraysite Operator position and are trying to determine the best path for the Assistant Superintendent of Water position. She posted a new job for a 1st class line worker due to an employee retiring. She has been working with departments on formatting and updating old job descriptions in preparation for a salary survey; she and Mary Bohlen have been working through the required information for the RFP process, which will be much easier to do when they are able to hire someone in the Administrative Assistant position. She and Tim Lawrence met with the Maryland Department of Labor Apprenticeship Navigator Bob Zimberoff to discuss the options for additional lineman certifications through the State of Maryland. She coordinated the completion of a Fire Alarm Inspection with Fire Protective Services, which is the first one that has been done since I have been employed here, and possibly longer than that. Lastly, she met with the Mayor, Mary Bohlen, and Arnold Downing to discuss retention efforts. Mayor Tyndall thanked her for taking on so many safety initiatives over the past year; she said she wants to be sure her and staff are safe, especially when it comes to preventive measures, they can take to correct issues.

6. Comments from the Council:

Vice-President Burrell reported that he still had major issues with the intersection of Bay Street and Route 113 and the issues on Seahawk Road; they need to make SHA aware of their concerns.

Councilmember Nichols reported that National Night Out was a huge success.

Councilmember Knerr said there are many manhole covers on Bay Street that SHA need to correct because they are well below grade and need corrected or lifted if possible.

Councilmember Orris reported that National Night Out and Peach Festival were both very successful and have grown so much over the years.

7. Comments from the Mayor:

Mayor Tyndall thanked staff and the community for the success of National Night Out and Peach Festival. He said he liked that Mr. Charles has been adding flags at Henry Park for holidays and events. He gave an update of County funding and stated that he requested funding for a wastewater treatment facility upgrade and for a pedestrian bridge on Route 113 and said unfortunately, neither one was successful. Lastly, he stated that the Mayor, Council, and Department Heads would be meeting with SHA on Wednesday, August 10th to discuss the Main Street paving project and lingering issues with other projects.

8. Comments from the Public

Resident Tony Weeg stated that there needs to be a crosswalk in place at Dollar General and at Food Lion before someone gets hurt. Ms. Bohlen stated that they can always ask again, but in the past SHA has said they do not want them in place unless they are in line with a stop light.

Resident Steve Green said he is happy to see the Town is building its reserve funds. He said Peach Fest was very successful and he thinks the Town should consider closing Main Street to make the event safer for attendees.

Mary Hedleskey asked when the stores on Main Street would be fixed because they are in terrible shape and are not pleasing to look at; Mr. Engelhart said they are waiting on architectural plans before they can be issued any permits to begin work.

9. Comments from the Press – none.

10. Adjournment:

On the motion of Vice-President Burrell, second by Councilmember Knerr, the Mayor and Council meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:45 PM.

Project Details

Project Title: Stephen Decatur Park Inclusive Playground

Please explain the public need for the proposed project: Explain why this
project is being developed/acquired and how it relates to other local
facilities/plans.

The creation of an inclusive playground for children of all abilities has been expressed frequently, and repeatedly, by residents and other park visitors, the Berlin Parks Commission and the Mayor and Council. During the development of a Town Strategic Plan several years ago – which included multiple public input meetings and workshops with Town personnel and elected officials – the number one priority indicated was the Town's Parks and Recreation facilities as a whole. Given a recent inspection of Stephen Decatur Park's equipment, the Mayor and Council voted to move the creation of an inclusive playground to the number one priority.

Stephen Decatur Park is the Town's most popular park and is a frequent site for daycare and school field trips, family gatherings and other organized events, as well as a large volume of "drop-in" visitors. In addition to Decatur Park features a Nature Trail and Pond, a walking path, numerous, scattered playground pieces, a pavilion and picnic tables and grills. There are also four tennis courts that were completely replaced in 2018 utilizing Community Parks and Playgrounds and Program Open Space funding. A nine-hole disc golf course was funded and installed by a local non-profit in 2021.

2. Please explain the public benefits associated with the proposed project: How do these benefits address the purpose of the Community Parks and Playgrounds Program?

Berlin continually seeks to enhance, improve and upgrade our park facilities and has partnered with Community Parks and Playgrounds several times to accomplish projects that would otherwise not be within financial reach. The replacement of the older playground structures with a modern, ADA compliant, inclusive playground will be a significant improvement and upgrade to the park, offering users a more enjoyable experience.

The inclusive playground will be built to encourage children, adults and families of all abilities to play together. The equipment will be designed to address the needs of every child. It will have pieces that are accessible

by all and will also include climbing apparatus, swings, a walking bridge and auditory equipment.

3. Please explain the low impact development techniques incorporated in the proposed project: What measures are being used to minimize the effect of stormwater runoff? What environmentally sensitive materials and/or green building techniques are being used in your proposed project?

For its size, Berlin is a model community for environmental stewardship; from being one of the first communities in the state of Maryland to mandate household recycling to being the first Sustainable Maryland Community to our most recent efforts including partnership with organizations dedicated to the preservation of our area's natural, cultural and historic resources. Berlin has enacted a Purchasing Policy which encourages staff to consider the environment in all aspects of purchasing and Berlin makes every effort as an organization to reduce and minimize our environmental impact whenever possible.

Berlin was the first community in Maryland to create a Stormwater Utility and to codify our efforts toward stormwater mitigation. As with all projects in Town, this project will be subject to Stormwater review and our on-call Stormwater engineer will review the final site plans prior to the start of construction.

The inclusive playground will incorporate as many of the existing trees as possible and have a rubber surface graded appropriately to insure minimum stormwater runoff. Working with the Town's contractual engineering firms and the as-yet-to-be-determined playground designer/installer, the Town will consider creative and effective ways to mitigate stormwater runoff directly associated with the playground area.

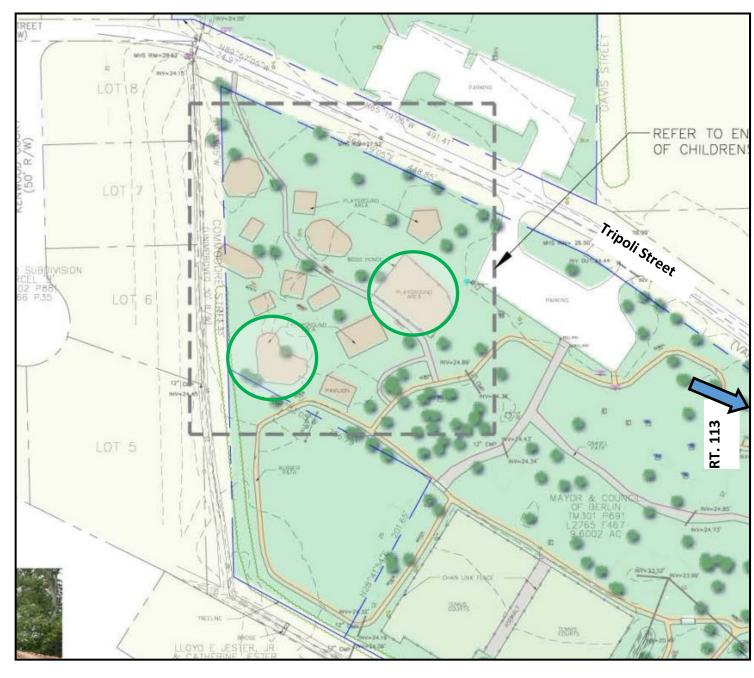


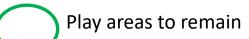


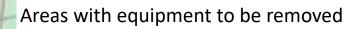

ORDINANCE 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BERLIN, MARYLAND, A MARYLAND

MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AMENDING CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE II, SECTION 8-30, CONCERNING

REGULATIONS GOVERNING SHORT TERM RENTALS OF DWELLINGS LOCATED WITHIN THE TOWN OF

BERLIN

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BERLIN THAT CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE II,

SECTION 8-30 BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

§8-30. Short Term Rental Licensing.

- (a) Generally. It is the intent of this section and the regulations stated herein to maintain the character of residential neighborhoods in the Town of Berlin and to protect the health, safety and general welfare of residents while allowing short term rentals to exist under certain conditions and circumstances.
- (b) Definitions.
 - Permanent Residence means a dwelling unit, located within the Town of Berlin, in which the owner resides for an aggregate of at least 180 days annually and the dwelling unit carries the official designation as the owners' principal residence in accordance with the criteria governing the State of Maryland Department of Assessment and Taxation Homestead Tax Credit Program. Short Term Residential Rental means the use of all or any part of a dwelling unit to provide accommodations, not to exceed 28 consecutive days, to guests for sleeping or lodging purposes in exchange for a monetary remuneration, including accommodations facilitated by an internet hosting platform. A Bed and Breakfast is not included in this definition.
- (c) Eligible Zone. Short Term Residential rentals are permitted in the incorporated limits of the

 Town of Berlin in permanent residences within the R-1, R-2, R-3, R-4, B-1, B-2, and B-3 Districts,

 subject to the licensing requirements and regulations contained herein.

- LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BERLIN IN PERMANENT RESIDENCES WITHIN THE R-1 RESIDENCE
 DISTRICT AND R-2 RESIDENCE DISTRICT SUBJECT TO THE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS AND
 REGULATIONS CONTAINED HEREIN. RENTAL UNITS WITHIN THE R-3 APARTMENT DISTRICT, R-4
 RESIDENCE DISTRICT, B-1 TOWN CENTER DISTRICT, B-2 SHOPPING DISTRICT, AND B-3 GENERAL
 BUSINESS DISTRICT ARE PERMITTED SUBJECT TO THE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS AND
 REGULATIONS CONTAINED HEREIN. RENTAL UNITS IN ANY ZONING DISTRICT MUST ALSO
 COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR DWELLING UNITS CONTAINED IN THE CODE OF THE
 TOWN OF BERLIN, CHAPTER 108, "ZONING," AND CHAPTER 6, "BUILDINGS AND BUILDING
 REGULATIONS."
- (d) Requirements. Any dwelling unit or portion thereof offered as a short term rental shall conform to the provisions of this Section.
 - (1) License. Prior to offering a dwelling unit or portion thereof as a short term rental, the property owner shall file an application for a short term residential rental license on forms provided by the Town. The application must be accompanied by an initial application fee in the amount of \$350.00 and the property owner must agree to make the dwelling unit available for inspection in order to verify that the dwelling unit is in compliance with all applicable building code provisions, including those of the Worcester County Fire Marshal's office. Applications must include a floorplan indicating the intended rental space and an emergency egress plan. Floorplans with an emergency egress plan are required to be posted in each rented sleeping area of a short term rental. Upon passing said inspection, the property owner will be issued an annual short term residential rental license upon the payment of an annual license fee of \$200.00.

 The license must be renewed annually, and the Town of Berlin reserves the right to

inspect subject properties at any time and before annual renewal. Each property owner shall provide the name and contact information for a responsible agent(s) who are available for contact twenty-four (24) hours per day and seven (7) days per week. A responsible agent(s) must be capable of responding to the property twenty-four hours per day and seven days per week and be located within a thirty (30) mile radius of the Town of Berlin's incorporated limits. The licensee is responsible for ensuring accurate emergency contact information is on file with the Town of Berlin. The rental license shall be posted in both a prominent interior location and a prominent exterior location on the addressed side and visible from the roadway. -All advertising, whether by print, electronic, audible, or in any other forms or substance designed or used to inform as to the availability of any property for rent which is the subject of the license, shall contain the valid rental license number associated with the property. A short term residential rental license is not transferable.

Short term residential units are subject to the State of Maryland lodging taxes as administered by the Worcester County Maryland Treasurer's office.

- (2) Duration of License. Licenses are issued for the duration of one (1) fiscal year concurrent with the Town of Berlin's fiscal year. Licenses will not be pro-rated.
- (3) Renewal of License. A Short Term Rental License may be renewed as long as the licensee is in compliance with this Section and other Sections of the Town Code and upon payment of the annual license fee of \$200.00.
- (4) Lapse of License. Short Term Rental Licenses that are not in compliance with this Section or other Sections of the Town Code for more than thirty (30) calendar days will be deemed expired and must complete a new application.
- (5) Occupancy. Every bedroom occupied for sleeping accommodations shall contain not less than 70

square feet of floor area unobstructed other than by furniture for each occupant. The number of occupants shall not exceed the sum total of all occupants permitted in each bedroom of the structure as per Chapter 6, Article V, "Housing Standards," Section 6-121, "Floor Space and Occupancy," of this Code.

- (6) Parking. One additional off-street parking space per each bedroom rented shall be required in addition to the parking required in the zoning district where the structure is located.
- (7) Records. A record of the names of all lodging guests who stay at the property, including their address, phone number, email address and the amount of monetary remuneration received shall be provided upon request to Town officials and to Worcester County Treasurer's Office officials.
- (8) Signage. On premise signage shall not be permitted on licensed property.
- (9) Events. The hosting of functions and events, including but not limited to wedding ceremonies, wedding receptions, family reunions, birthday and anniversary celebrations, corporate and employee parties, and other similar gatherings of persons other than the authorized lodging guests, shall be prohibited in association with any short term rentals, regardless of whether or not any form of compensation or barter has been paid or received by any individual or firm for the event.

The Mayor and Council by Resolution may establish additional standards, regulations, or require additional information as deemed necessary to enforce the provisions of this Section and protect the integrity of the community.

- (e) Violations. Violations and enforcement are the responsibility of the Planning Director or Housing

 Inspector pursuant to the Town Charter. A decision by the Planning Director to revoke a license
 may be appealed to the Housing Board of Review.
 - (1) Renting without a License. Rental of a property as defined by this Ordinance without a

license	will	result in a	reoccurring	fine	of \$600.00.

(2) Other Violations. A violation of any requirement of this Section or other Sections of the Town Code, excluding renting without a license as defined in Section (e)(I), will result in a Civil Violation of \$100.00. Repeat or continuing violations will result in a fine of \$200 .00 per day and may result in revocation of the Short Term Rental License for the remainder of the licensing period plus (1) year.
