BERLIN MAYOR AND COUNCIL Meeting Minutes Monday, March 22, 2021

7:00 PM REGULAR

REGULAR SESSION – Via Zoom

Present: Mayor Zackery Tyndall, Vice-President Dean Burrell, Councilmembers Troy Purnell, Jack Orris, Shaneka Nichols, and Jay Knerr.

Staff Present: Town Administrator Jeff Fleetwood, Deputy Town Administrator Mary Bohlen, Finance Director Natalie Saleh, Police Chief Arnold Downing, Economic and Community Development Director Ivy Wells, Planning Director David Engelhart, Public Works Superintendent Jimmy Charles, Town Attorney David Gaskill, and Administrative Manager Kelsey Jensen.

Due to the Coronavirus/Covid-19 State of Emergency, this meeting was broadcast live via Facebook with limited public attendance. Following a moment of silence and the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor Tyndall called the meeting to order at approximately 7:00 PM.

Town Administrator Jeffrey Fleetwood took a moment to introduce and welcome the new Public Works Superintendent Jimmy Charles.

3. Resolution 2021-02: Town's Reserve Policy

Town Administrator Jeffrey Fleetwood and Finance Director Natalie Saleh presented the reserve policy.

4. Ordinance 2021-01: Tax Rate Ordinance Public Hearing

Mayor Tyndall read an opening statement and stated that it is his position not to increase the tax rate. Town Administrator Jeffrey Fleetwood read the Ordinance on the record.

Mayor Tyndall opened the Public Hearing at 7:14 PM. Resident Marie Velong said she is glad to hear that it is being proposed at the same rate of \$.80. Town Administrator Jeffrey Fleetwood said it is a long process and his loyalty is with the Mayor and Council, Department Heads, Employees, and the citizens. Resident Gina Velong said it is great that it will remain the same, the Town needs to tighten the belts and evaluate important needs and table wants. Resident Robert Johnson asked when the citizens can review the budget(s) that were submitted to the Council. Mayor Tyndall said there is a time when the budget will go public, but that time is not yet. Resident Marie Velong said she resents what Mr. Fleetwood said, citizens should carry the most weight; she also said most employees do not even live in Town so they cannot care about it as the citizens do, their interest is only in their department, not the budget. Resident Carol Rose said she has worked with every employee here and they always have the best interest of the Town at heart regardless of where they live. Ms. Rose said she still has not seen a draft budget and thinks it is important to leave funding for improvements to roads; Mayor Tyndall said the discussion is about the tax rate, not the budget, but items that address flooding would fall in the Utility Budget. Ms. Rose then asked what was cut from the budget to balance it; Mayor Tyndall said salary increases and several other things; Ms. Rose said staff needs a COLA increase because the staff is important. Resident Jim Meckley said there should be no tax increase because there was a big increase two years ago, he feels the stimulus funds will help employees because he is sure most employees got it; the economy will get better, and maybe next year would be better. Lastly, a comment was made by Geraldine Rhock who said Germantown flooding needs addressed, the church is in Town; this comment was not addressed because it is unrelated to the topic. With no further comments, the Public Hearing ended at 7:30 PM.

Councilmember Knerr asked if the Department Heads can speak up and let them know if the requests, needs, and wants are in the budget they received. Mr. Fleetwood said Finance Director Natalie Saleh meets with all of the departments and gets a separate list of needs and wants, but he will allow them to speak up and say if those items were included. Planning Director David Engelhart said none of his wants are in this budget, he felt the budget was balanced on the backs of the employees. Vice-President Burrell asked if what he needed was in there; Mr. Engelhart said the needs are, but nothing more. Economic and Community Development Director Ivy Wells said

she has many concerns about the budget and proposed tax rate, her needs are in there, but nothing more, she wishes she was more involved in the budget process. Chief Downing said he wants to be sure he is speaking up for his staff and showing them support when they need it, he said many people leave other Towns to come work here because they get what they deserve. Chief Downing said education and training are a necessity and when it is not offered the employees take the hit, no one knows his budget needs like he does, so when cuts are made he feels that he should have had more of a say in where those cuts were made. Finance Director Natalie Saleh said she is proud of the employees and the Town and how well they work as a team to present a budget they worked hard on, the Council needs to look at the future, if they skip an increase this year then what about next year, they will need to keep tightening while costs continue to increase and each year it becomes harder to do. Public Works Superintendent Jimmy Charles said they need a street sweeper, and if they skip vital equipment it snowballs into future years. Deputy Town Administrator Mary Bohlen said her budget is relatively unchanged since it is related to the Parks, but feels it is important to note that we have very little turnover for a reason.

Councilmember Knerr said he has serious concerns with how the process was conducted and employee benefits shouldn't be cut. Mr. Fleetwood said the budget may still change because Health and Workers Compensation Insurance numbers are estimates. Administrative Manager Kelsey Jensen said it is important to know that employees used to receive a holiday one-time pay and that has decreased annually since she started, and then over the past few years it was no longer in the budget, she said she did write a letter requesting a \$100 one-time payment for employees last year because it was such a tough year for so many and thought it would boost morale, but it did not happen. Ms. Jensen also added that when she started the annual COLA was higher and it has gotten smaller over the years. Ms. Jensen said lastly, health insurance went up last year, so most employees' net pay went down.

Resident Rose Zollinger asked why the rate needs to be set before a feasible budget has been determined. Ms. Saleh said they need that tax rate to determine the revenues for producing the budget, it needs to come first. Councilmember Knerr said he thinks they need to take a long look at \$.80. Councilmember Orris said he found the process to be flawed, he expected to be more informed during the process. Mayor Tyndall said he keeps hearing people say two budgets, but that's not it, there is one budget, the one he has balanced, he said it is not an easy decision to make and that he disagrees that things are done on the backs of the employees. Mayor Tyndall said he reduced cell phone allowances, removed pay increases, and cut car allowances for three employees.

Vice-President Burrell said in a negotiation there is a conversation, he did not feel Mayor Tyndall was receptive enough to get others points of view, and only considered his own, he feels that the Council has always been very fair to the employees. Mayor Tyndall said he took an oath to the citizens and he has presented no increase in tax rate along with a balanced budget. Councilmember Knerr said he was never asked for his opinion and they did not get the budget until 9:00 PM on Friday so had three days to review it which is unacceptable. Mayor Tyndall said that is when the budget was updated and he wanted Council to have the most up-to-date budget, he feels he has gone above and beyond in answering all questions and responding quickly. Councilmember Knerr said they want to be helpful and involved in the process. Councilmember Nichols said it sounds like cuts were made to salaries, cell phones, vehicle allowances, and training; Mayor Tyndall said not training completely, but no national conferences and because of COVID, so many are held virtually now. Councilmember Nichols said so many of those trainings are vital for staff, the future is unknown so she is reluctant to put off a tax increase for another year. Resident Gina Velong said asked How does an examination of department line budget items affect promises made by elected Councilmembers? Keeping the tax rate as is was one of your

promises. Councilmember Nichols said she doesn't know how we can maintain the level of service and keep the rate where it is. Councilmember Purnell said not doing incremental increases was the biggest mistake made in the past and cutting the rate years ago was an even bigger mistake, he does not want this to affect employees and they need to have a capital budget for the roads. Councilmember Purnell said every penny generates \$47,657 a year, lastly, he mentioned that they adopted a reserve policy that tries to put \$100,000 away a year and that will not happen in this budget. Mayor Tyndall said that there is a line item in the budget for Highway User Revenue (HUR) funds which are funds passed through from the State that are used for streets and sidewalks, he cut Graham Ave and Stevenson Ln to purchase the new street sweeper. Councilmember Purnell said more cuts this year means more coming from the taxpayers later to make up for what we put off. Councilmember Knerr said they have a lot of work ahead of them and thinks a slow increase is important, therefore it is not too much to take on at once; he suggested \$.815, which is about \$60 annually to the average homeowner in Town. Ms. Saleh displayed a rate comparison for review. Mayor Tyndall added that \$.815 still will not cover the shortfall, it would need to be at least \$.83.

Resident Marie Velong said many citizens like her are on a fixed income and she knows they will probably increase water and stormwater rates. Vice-President Burrell wanted to hear other local tax rates; Ms. Jensen read the following from the County site: Worcester County collects the Real Property Tax for the towns of Berlin, Snow Hill, Pocomoke, and Ocean City. The current Berlin town tax rate is \$0.80 per \$100 of assessed value. The current Snow Hill town tax rate is \$0.86 per \$100 of assessed value. The Pocomoke town tax rate is \$0.9375 per \$100 of assessed value for owner-occupied property and \$1.1311 per \$100 of assessed value for all other properties. The tax rate for Ocean City is \$0.4559 per \$100 of assessed value. Mr. Fleetwood added that the Town is one of the few that doesn't charge for trash too.

Vice-President Burrell said that it is the Mayor's responsibility for presenting the budget, but they are responsible for setting the rate and voting. Mayor Tyndall said the Town has language when the Council needs to receive the budget, but he is not sure if there is language on when to receive the tax rate. Town Attorney David Gaskill said there is no language on when they need to receive the tax rate, but the budget is 32 days ahead of the fiscal year. Ms. Saleh added that the State needs the tax rate by June 1st, it drives the budget. Vice-President Burrell said that what was presented puts the Town in jeopardy and impacts the quality of service the Town can provide, the longevity of employees directly correlates with the quality of service. Councilmember Knerr said he presented \$.815, Councilmember Purnell presented \$.89, he takes citizens' concerns to heart. Mr. Gaskill read section C3-10 from the Charter titled "Adoption of Ordinances". Based on what Mr. Gaskill read, Vice-President Burrell said so it does not need to be decided tonight, we have 60 days from the introduction. Mayor Tyndall said his recommendation will not change to remain at \$.80 and he is confident that we can move forward with that rate. Councilmember Orris said from a timing perspective he would prefer to wait to set the rate. Councilmember Purnell said \$.80 is going backward.

Councilmember Knerr made a Motion to amend the tax rate from \$.80 to \$.815. Mayor Tyndall said that would not cover the shortfall. With no second the Motion died.

Vice-President Burrell said that the projected income is not promised and how will we handle it if incomes are not as expected. Mr. Fleetwood said we have also budgeted grants going out, \$20,000 to Atlantic General Hospital, \$40,000 to Worcester Youth and Family, and \$400,000 to Berlin Fire and Berlin Emergency Services. Mayor Tyndall said that if grant revenues are directly related to projects and do not come through, then the project would not happen. Councilmember Orris asked why Berlin would pay for all the costs associated with Rails to Trails if it connects to

Snow Hill; Mayor Tyndall said because it is in Berlin, but when it comes to connecting in the future, he has spoken with the Mayor and Town Administrator in Snow Hill and after their elections, he will speak to the new Mayor, but if the funding does not come through then the project will not be completed. Councilmember Nichols asked if we agree on \$.815 where will the money go; Mr. Gaskill said it is the Mayor's budget, but the Council has the right to amend. Mr. Fleetwood commented that the \$450,000 grant from the County is a general fund grant that comes to the Town unrestricted for General Fund purposes. Also, Mr. Fleetwood mentioned that the employee pay increases are just shy of \$50,000. Colin Zimmer with Coastal Association of Realtors suggested incremental increases over the next few years, so citizens can budget for the future, he suggests incremental or better yest, keep it the same. Mr. Gaskill said this Council cannot bind future Councils to a set rate. Councilmember Purnell said \$.80 is going backward and snowballing future increases.

Councilmember Purnell made a Motion to amend the tax rate from \$.80 to \$.86. With no second the Motion died.

Vice-President Burrell made a Motion to amend the tax rate from \$.80 to \$.83. With no second the Motion died.

Councilmember Purnell asked what happens if they reject it; Mr. Gaskill said they would need to take a look and make a new plan.

Councilmember Orris made a Motion to postpone this decision until there is a more solid idea on revenues and funding. Gaskill said the Charter requires a specified future date. Ms. Bohlen added that the First Reading of the Budget is May 10th, and the Public Hearing would be on May 24th. Ms. Saleh said the budget meetings are further out than 60 days so it would need to be addressed before then which may mean creating a special meeting. Mayor Tyndall said without this rate being set we cannot come up with a firm budget, this is as firm as it will be. Councilmember Orris withdrew his Motion.

Resident Marie Velong asked what is needed to give employees raises; Mr. Fleetwood said \$.01.

Mayor Tyndall said you need \$.83 to close the gap; Vice-President Burrell asked why he did not set the rate at that amount if that is what we need to close the gap. Mayor Tyndall said he found a way to make \$.80 work. Vice-President Burrell said they need to stop playing politics and do what is best for the Town. Ms. Saleh said in her professional opinion she recommends and stands by \$.83; Mayor Tyndall respects that but disagrees. Councilmember Purnell said \$.83 still will not get us ahead in any way.

On the Motion of Councilmember Nichols, second by Vice-President Burrell, a Motion to amend the tax rate from \$.80 to \$.83 was not approved by the following vote:

5. Town Administrator's Report - Jeffrey Fleetwood

Mr. Fleetwood reported that tomorrow there will be a pre-construction meeting with State Highway regarding the 113/376 expansion project. April 3rd there will be a meeting to discuss the solar project on Schoolfield Street. Lastly, on March 29th at noon at the Public Works Yard, there will be a retirement ceremony for Public Works Superintendent Dave Wheaton.

6. Departmental Reports:

a. Economic and Community Development Director – Ivy Wells

Ms. Wells said she is working on a COVID Grant and has 40 applicants.

b. Public Works Superintendent - Jimmy Charles

Mr. Charles said he is working to beautify the Town this week they will begin focusing on the parks. Mayor Tyndall complimented the new flags at Stephen Decatur Park.

c. Administrative Manager - Kelsey Jensen

Ms. Jensen said she sent an advertisement to the local paper for a seasonal part-time general laborer.

7. Comments from the Mayor:

Mayor Tyndall thanked everyone for the concerns and discussions regarding the tax rate ordinance. He also mentioned that he is following the American Relief Act funding and is optimistic about receiving it.

8. Comments from the Council:

Councilmember Nichols said she appreciates the hard work that is put into the budget and tax rate and is not happy with how things progressed this evening.

Councilmember Knerr said this entire process seems backward and wanted to make a motion that in future years when a tax rate is presented, a balanced budget will be provided at that same time. Mayor Tyndall said this requires more than a Motion, it is a change to the Charter. Town Attorney David Gaskill said the State requires the Tax Rate by June 1st and the Mayor does not have to submit the budget until May 29th (32 days before July 1), and this would be the first reading. Deputy Town Administrator Mary Bohlen said a Resolution was passed in 2019 that outlines this procedure, she would suggest that at the next meeting it be provided for review, and at that point, you can determine how to change that process because they have the right and ability to change that process. Mr. Gaskill said it would be beneficial to review that process and the required dates and guidelines before making any changes. Councilmember Knerr asked if they are suggesting he take this up at future meeting; Ms. Bohlen said she can send it to him tomorrow and then he can determine if he would like to amend it.

Councilmember Orris thanked everyone for their work on the budget/tax rate and said it is not an easy decision to make, but it was a reasonable compromise.
