Q.1: On page 5 of the RFQ 2025-01 General On-Call Engineering Services, it is stated that under the Contract Award Period section, that the minimum term for the awarded contract would be 5 years. It is our understanding that funding agencies, such as MDE typically only accept On-Call Engineering Service contracts for a maximum term of 3 years, with two allowable one-year extensions of the original term. Can the Town confirm that the contract term meets the typical funding agency requirements?

A.1: Please refer to page 6, first paragraph under "Additional Important Information", where it is indicated that additional firms may be retained "for individual projects on an as-needed basis." In the case of specific projects that may be funded by outside agencies, and therefore have specific terms, conditions, and requirements, the Town may consult with the applicable funding agency to determine if the on-call firm may be used, or if the Town will be required to issue a separate Request for Proposal for the specific project.
