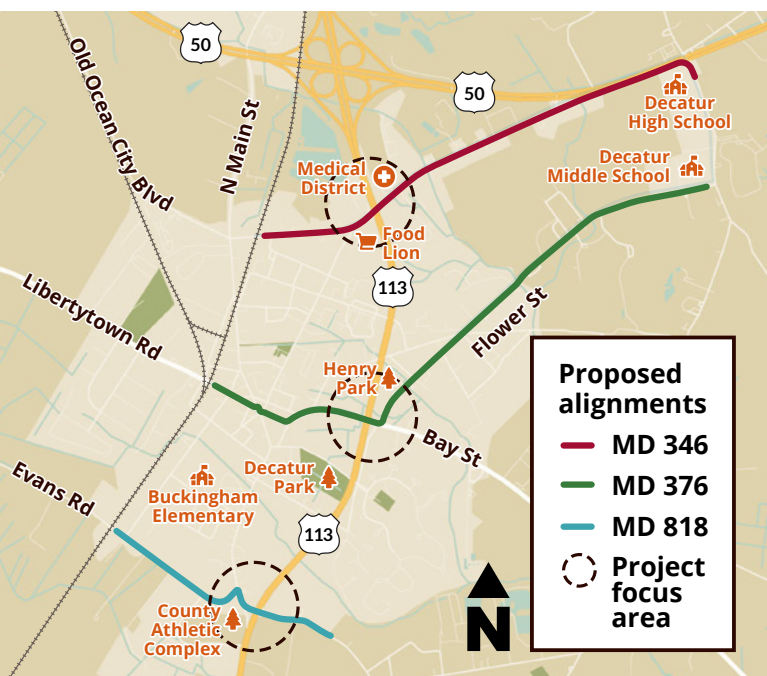


HELP SHAPE THE FUTURE OF SAFE CONNECTIONS IN BERLIN.



The Town of Berlin and the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) are exploring where a potential bicycle and pedestrian bridge could be located along intersections at US 113, at either MD 346 (Old Ocean City Boulevard), MD 376 (Bay Street) or MD 818 (South Main Street/ Germantown Road). The study is funded by a US Department of Transportation (USDOT) grant.

The goal of the bridge is to improve access and safety for Berlin residents and visitors crossing at these major intersections. As seen on the map below, the western edge of the bridge alignments would connect to a Worcester County planned project to turn an abandoned rail line into a recreational trail.



This study is a feasibility study for a future pedestrian and bicycle bridge, not a construction plan. The project would need to go through all required permitting processes, such as the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Your feedback will help advance the study and shape how people move, connect and enjoy Berlin for years to come.
